	 The item presented to BOS was approved with following suggestions: The detailed syllabus of English and Communication Skills and Personality Development and Job Skills of Semester I and II was approved with detailed discussion. Titles of some of the topics should be changed in order to cover a broader aspect. Experiential learning to be focused. Time should be extended to give more weightage to certain chapters. Combination of E &CS and PD & JS should be there throughout all semesters from next semester on wards. Use of Audio- visual aids should be part of teaching.(Video counseling) Certain less important chapters (application letter, interview skills etc.) to be interchanged to PD II. Workshops should be organized to enhance the awareness of the faculties on Life Skills education. Dr. Vadaya showed his willingness to train the faculties. Students' vision for expected outcomes should be clarified at the end of the course. 	
3	Assessment scheme	
	The item presented to BOS was approved with following suggestions: Assessment for Life skills is required to be different from other domain subjects Midterm examination should be avoided; instead continuous evaluation is to be carried out. Rest of the assessment scheme was to be agreed upon.	e
