 - b. Subject : Networking Fundamentals
 - i. Explanation of wireless and wired NIC Cards should be included in topic NIC in Unit-VI
 - ii. Various network devices specifications from Cisco & D-link can be included for discussion and comparison to give more insight to the topics of Unit-VI
